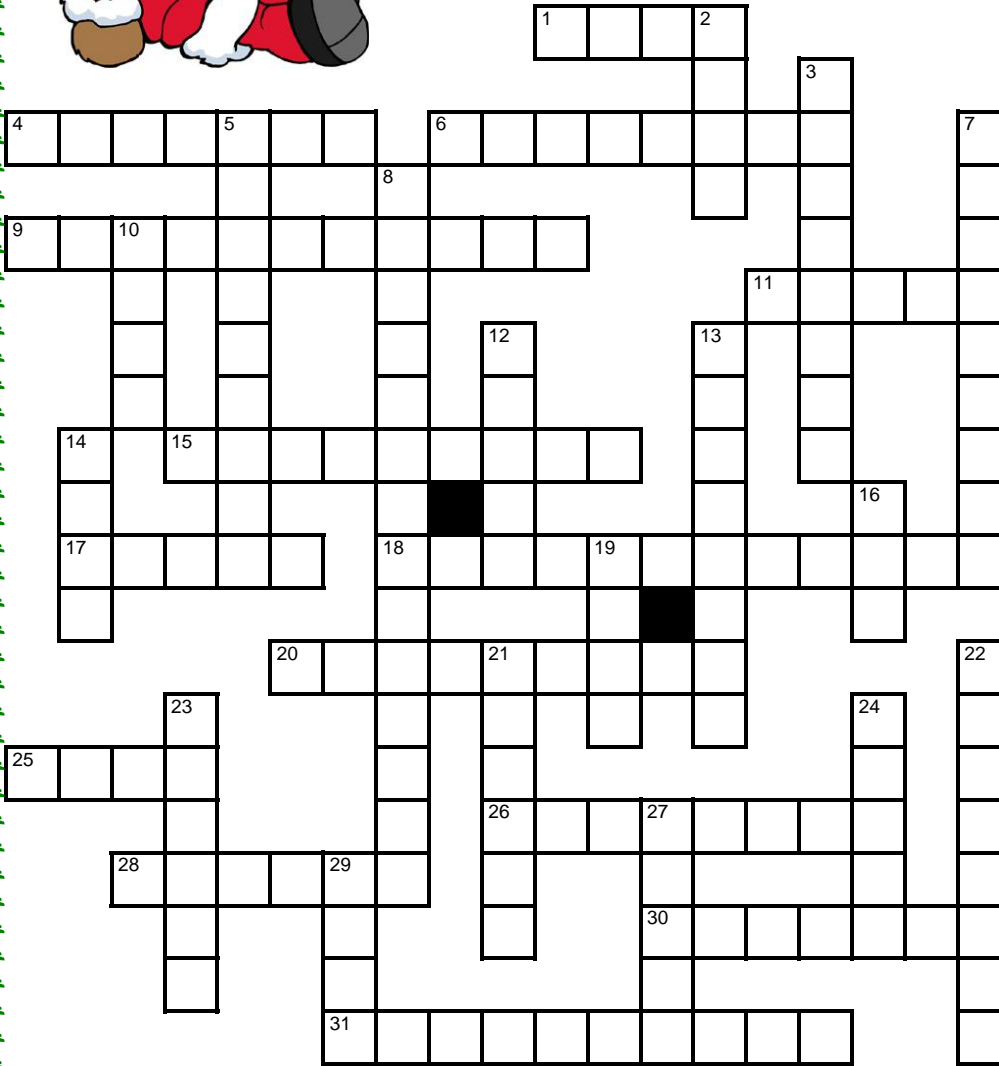

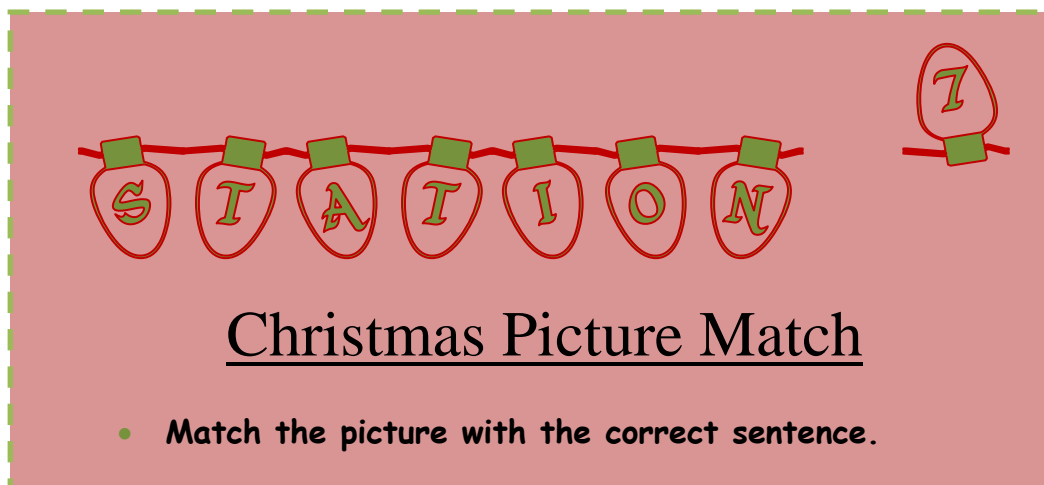

Secret Santa

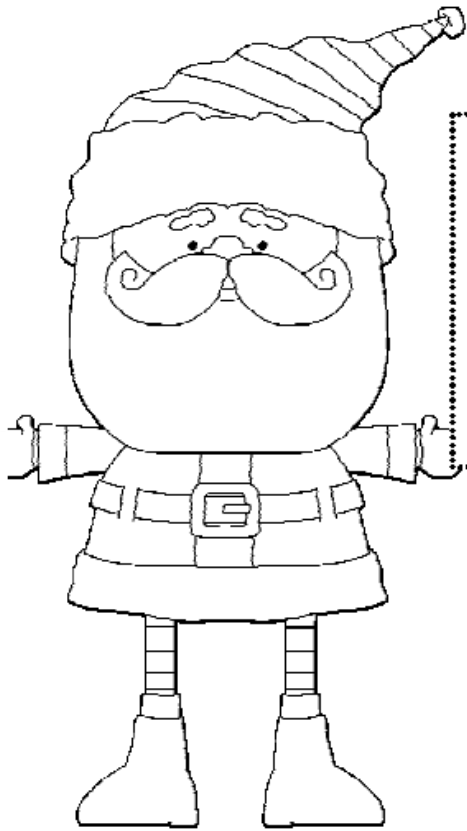
- Make copies for your students and pass them out at least a week before you want the gift giving to begin. It's fine if the whole class does not want to participate. As the designated Secret Santa organizer, you will want the forms turned in at least 4 days before the gift giving begins. Have your class (each person who participates) choose a survey, set a start date and let the fun begin! Typically, there will be four days of small gifts and the final day will be a bigger gift when the Secret Santas reveal themselves.

- Have students complete the following personal profile. Teacher will choose one sheet at random every once in a while.
- Teacher will read clues one at a time while students try to guess who the secret person is.

Guess Who? Interactive

- Have students complete the following personal profile. Students do not write their names on the sheet.
- Teacher distributes one survey per student after brainstorming question forms with the class.
- Students either walk around and ask classmates questions to try to guess who their form belongs to, or throughout the week, students collect information on teammates when they have a chance or when the teacher gives a few minutes.
- Identities are revealed on the last day before the Holidays.
