


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3. *Who do you think Mr. Porter is?*

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

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


*2. Compare your answers with a partner and correct the information if necessary. When done, re-read the section (P.5-6) and correct or add information where needed.*




### Task 3: Cassette 1: side A


1. *What does Tyler take away from Hannah? Why was taking that away significant for Hannah?*
