ACTIVITY 1:

I HAVE, WHO HAS?

- Distribute to each student a card. Teacher starts off by calling out the card "I have *RED*, Who has *Blue*?" Student that has "I have *Blue*..." stands up and says "I have *Blue*, who has *green*?"
- Game continues until everyone is standing.
- Switch cards and play again.
- Students practice **I have, who has?**

ACTIVITY 4: THE RAINBOW SIGHT WORD GAME

- To have access to the documents

1. Put the color word cards face down in a pile.
2. Get a playing piece for each player.
3. Take turns picking up a card and reading the color word. Follow the arrows on the path as you move your playing piece to the closest coin of that color. Players may share the same space.
4. If a player is near the end of the path, and there is none of the color he draws ahead of him, he moves ahead to the pot of gold and wins the game.

Pick and choose activities you wish to do with your students using Appendix 4.













Students write their name in the center. Children take turns spinning; when they land on a shape they identify, trace and color it. The 1st one who completes their quilt is the winner. The rest of the players then color in their quilts. If you want to display these mini ones as a big class quilt, have students glue their playing sheet to a piece of construction paper. Pre-cut the paper in a large variety of colors. Arrange the pieces on a bulletin board or wall to look like a large quilt. To add a bit more pizzazz, make a copy of your group photo, cut the students' faces into ovals and have them choose their favorite shape to glue it on.










Quick Quilt Shape Spinner

PLANNING TIPS AND SUGGESTIONS FOR YOUR **MIX IT UP! PARTY**

SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES AND GAMES:

- **Have a dress-up party!** Encourage kids to dress up in their favorite mix of colors.
- **Make friends!** To kick-off the festivities, have each party guest introduce themselves by saying “Hi, my name is _____ and my favorite color is _____.” Then have kids team up based on favorite colors for the other fun activities below.
- **Read-aloud time!** Read *Mix It Up!* to the kids and have volunteers come up to read each page with you.
- **“I Spy” game.** As the party host, ask your guests to guess what nearby object you are thinking of based on one or two color-related clues. For example, if you have your eye on a green balloon, easy clues could be “I spy something that is the same color as grass!” or “I spy something that is a mix of yellow and blue!”
- **Time to color!** Distribute plenty of white paper along with crayons, colored pencils, scissors, and tape. Encourage kids to be creative and try many different color combinations.
